MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

19 years of age or older, able to provide a birth certificate.



Have successfully completed at least 4 years of Secondary School education or equivalent.

Be mentally and physically fit to perform the duties.



Previous policing related experience and law and security courses an asset.

Posses a valid drivers license.

Certified by a physician as fit for duty.

Complete all medical and security clearance as needed.

CONSTABLE

Six Nations Police Service sends the successful candidate to the Ontario Police College and the OPP Academy to receive training.

The term for pre-recruit, OPC and post recruit training is approximately 5 consecutive months.

They must achieve certification to continue on as a Six Nations Police Service uniform member. Constables are assigned a coach officer who provides on the job training for several months once they are on active patrol.
